# quick start guide



#### Start

When you first open Express, you may need to click List

This will display all available dictations in your Job List.

The quickest way to request a dictation is from the Job List. Simply double-click the dictation.



Or you can select a Request method (My Jobs, Oldest to Newest, Job List Order) and click Request Job

**My Jobs:** Requests dictations assigned only to you **Oldest to Newest:** Gives you the oldest dictation **Job List Order:** Opens dictations in the order you have them listed in your Job List



If you open a dictation you do not want, click Return This will put the dictation back In Queue to type at a later time.



## Type


**After requesting a dictation** the Job Command buttons will go from gray to white and become active.



**Return** puts the dictation back In Queue.

**Skip:** Returns current dictation and opens the next one (if available).

**Complete:** Click when you've finished typing a dictation. This will change its status from *In Queue* to *Completed*.

#### List

The Job List shows what dictations are available to request and their information. Filters can narrow the results shown.

In this image, the Job List is set to display all *In Queue* dictations with no filters enabled.

The Job List shows important data, such as who dictated it (**Author** column), client/case/patient number (**Subject** column), work type (**WT** column), typist assignment (**Typist** column), **length** (hh:mm:ss format), and dictation date/time (**AuthTime** & **AuthDate** columns).

To only show dictations by a particular Author: Enter their ID in the Author ID field and click



#### Status menu options:

In Queue shows dictations that need to be typed. Completed shows dictations already typed. In Use shows dictations currently open.

### Save

If you Save a dictation, Express will remember your position for future playback.



Ex: With a 10 minute dictation you click Save at the 5 minute mark. The next time you open that dictation the audio will begin playing at 5 minutes.

#### To retrieve a Saved dictation:

Set the Status filter to *Saved* (this will display all saved files) and then double-click the desired dictation.
